Henderson Bursary Award 2022

Each year, as part of our commitment to encourage promising new artists, the Pittenweem Arts Festival awards an artist's bursary. As from this year, the award will be known as the Henderson Award in acknowledgment of long term funding from David and Sheila Henderson.

The successful applicant will benefit from a bursary package of £1000, which includes an exhibition venue, and covers accommodation for ten days and expenses.

Established in 1982, the Pittenweem Arts Festival is a major visual arts event. Based in an historic fishing village in the East Neuk of Fife, the festival attracts over 20,000 visitors every August. It provides the ideal platform for artists to promote their work to both the public and international art professionals.

We are delighted to accept applications from:

- Final year degree students in any Scottish School of Art or in an arts-based discipline at any recognised Scottish Institution
- Degree level graduates within the last three years from any Scottish School of Art or in an arts-based discipline at any recognised Scottish Institution

The Bursary Award winner will be selected and notified by the end of March. Please read carefully the conditions of acceptance on the application form.

The deadline for applications is March 15th 2022

Should Covid 19 restrictions be required during the Festival, we will inform you of those. Artists will be expected to conform to the Festival's conditions of exhibiting to safeguard the public and themselves
