Conditions for participation and explanatory notes

Conditions for participation

- The registration fee and form must be received by March 15
- The artist will not represent or advertise any commercial gallery or organisation
- The work of **ONLY** the artist named in this application will be exhibited. No other artist(s) will be shown in the venue unless they have paid the registration fee
- The work must be predominantly new for 2022
- The artist must hold a Public Liability insurance certificate (Try www.a-n.co.uk)
- Health & Safety: venues must display an IN CASE OF FIRE and EXIT poster(s) where appropriate

- It is illegal to drink alcohol in the streets in Pittenweem

- *Please note:* The registration fee is non-refundable except in cases of illness, family bereavement or in other exceptional circumstances, at the discretion of the Board. Where adverse weather conditions cause traffic or parking arrangements to be altered, the festival Board advises that they are not responsible for any resulting financial losses suffered by artists. Exhibitors may wish to insure against this possibility

- *Should Covid 19 restrictions be required during the Festival, we will inform you of those. Artists will be expected to conform to the Festival's conditions of exhibiting to safeguard the public and themselves.*

Notes

Entry in festival brochure and entry on festival website

- **Text description of artist's work:** no more than **30** words. Shorter text means a bigger, therefore better, image in the brochure

- **Images of up to FOUR, and at least, TWO pieces of work being exhibited**

These images will be used for the brochure and the website. Images should be in the form of a .jpg at high resolution. One is used for the brochure (you can specify which one) and print is at a higher resolution than viewing on a screen. In other words, make the files as large as possible. The file names of the images should be: the title of the work and the artist's name

Artists' Talks

In 2011 we introduced the idea of free Artists' Talks to the festival and are encouraged to continue through positive feedback from the public. Although some artists had fewer people attending, others had a full venue and an enjoyable time at their talks. We hope that you will take part again this year.

The idea is to offer a short, informal talk in your venue, (15 minutes and questions), more like a chat about art and the way you work. Alternatively you could offer a demonstration. The talk/demonstration would be timetabled: people will just show up at your chosen time. It is up to the artist how many bodies the venue can comfortably accommodate.

Experience showed that timing and advertising are crucial for attracting visitors. We will try to spread the events evenly throughout the week.

Timetables of the talks/demonstrations will be in the brochure and on the website. During the festival there will be Talks posters in the festival office and each participating artist will be given a poster for outside their venue.
